September Agenda Items

1. Change of vetting voting process
Motion passed for vetting voting to be done on Game 4 going forward and not waiting for next committee meeting to speed the process up
2. Addition of power to container
Daniel is going to work on power for the new container which can be set up to circuit breaker with generator outside
Extra solar panels will be added to the container also to add extra backup for charging batteries etc
USB charging ports for Eftpos, power for laptop (generator), lights, power sockets
Bill for materials to be provided for re-imbusement
Look at better battery and inverter for solar panels in the admin
3. Removal of some trees in safe zone
Contact made with ranger for permission to remove trees from the safe zone

8. Website upgrade

Server is still with Robert and in the stages of moving to Vision in Te Puke (\$45 per month with includes website upgrades etc)
Looking at integrating payments and adding a user log in page
9. A simpler plan for hires outgoing + incoming at game days
Linking Gun, Mask together and having these pre-allocated for game day
A couple of members have taken about 8-10 guns to be fixed – details of costs to fix for parts has been requested so re-imburement can be made back to the members doing the work
Look at sourcing replacements for hire masks due to fogging issues
